### IYT International Bareboat Skipper Certificate (BBS) courses 2012:

**IYT International Bareboat Skipper Certificate** is a certificate for those candidates who wish to take command of a recreational private yacht up to 65 feet and its crew in coastal waters up to a distance of 20 miles offshore in mainly light to moderate conditions.

Recommended entry level: to have logged over 200 nautical miles and 10 days at sea or to be holder of IYT SPB or RYA PBL2, Boat owners, skipper of a boat without prior license.

**Rate AED 10.900**

Course fee includes theoretical and practical training, fuel, course notes, IYT passport and certificate. Chart plotter (AED 140), divider (AED 145), chart number 1 (AED 100) and training sea chart (AED 135) are **not** included.
